Grant Review Team Requirements and Dates:

Participating in the Grant Review Team is a commitment and we want to better clarify what is required as you will spend up to 20 hours preparing for and reviewing applications to work through how to identify finalists.

Zoom meeting (required)	Review Team to align on the process as well as how to identify and respond to bias during the review process.

March 8, view video (required)	Grant Review Scoring – video
Time commitment ~30 min	
March 9-19 application review	Review and comment on all received applications.
Time commitment ~ 7-15 hours	Conduct additional research as needed. Reviews MUST BE SUBMITTED BY MARCH 19.

March 28 and 30, 7-9pm (required)	Semi-finalists selection meetings
Time commitment - 4 hours	
March 31-April 26, semi finalist review (optional)	Opportunities to participate in semi-finalists interviews and financial review.
May 3, 7-9pm (required)	Finalist selection meeting
Time commitment ~ 4 hours,	
including prep	
June 5 - Annual Meeting	We will gather as a full membership, learn about grantee
(optional, but encouraged)	finalists, and vote as a membership on how to allocate
	our collective funds.
